Director's Report:

- Duffy house engineer has raised the floor, most headers are in for the windows, windows should start next week and then the siding. It will be painted when the weather gets warmer. They are trying to work out a deal for the interior work.
- Met with Rotary today who is unhappy about an enclosure made at Duffy to protect equipment. They want the building back to its original state. Jim pitched two options to rectify this. Rotary wants the entire building empty of all P&R equipment. To build another building involves Pinelands and Wetlands and will cost close to \$60k as opposed to a \$10k option and a \$35k option. The next meeting will be next week.
- There is an art show coming to town on April 30th with a rain date of May 14th. This will be on Main Street and they have asked for our vendor list. Jim is acting as a consultant. Jim's concern

- is this event being so close to our event for money coming in. They said they are targeting a different clientele.
- Jim pitched the idea for 2017 as marketing the music festival as the Music Festival / Town Appreciation Night. This is just a thought for next year. No one is opposed to doing it for this year if there is time to added it to the marketing material.
- Gina Martucci is opening an art school on Main Street. She is going to take over painting our signs no more spray paint. She will create eight signs for each event.
- Jim provided handouts for the signage this year.
- A new camp will start this year for high school aged students; students will need to qualify for this program.
- Working on a large sign option with investors in the area near Geets.
- Little League field was the worst of the 17 fields in town. It has been redone and edged and a fence was added. It's improved. Also putting in a "big green monster" on all fields but it will be blue for the township colors.
