Representing Williamstown Sunrise Rotary – This is the 3<sup>rd</sup> year the Rotary is sponsoring the 2<sup>nd</sup> stage for the Music Festival. This year he reached out to the high school looking for bands / singers and had 10 different acts sign up. He is currently working on getting a set list. Some of the bands are originals; 3 bands, singers and rappers.

What is the world record for the largest shaving cream fight? The record is 915 people. Chris has reached out to Guinness Book of World Records and would like to use this record as a fund raising opportunity. It would be \$10 per entry. He would like to coordinate this with the Halloween Parade / Fall Festival (same day). Donna is concerned about the time frame in between the events but it might work if Rotary is running it then P&R wouldn't need to spare people. Registration would be around 2pm but Jim thinks it would need to be earlier. A suggestion was made for the Rotary to have a table at the Fall Festival to register participants in the morning. They are also working on doing an online registration. Jim suggested saving this event for 2016 during the Music Festival. Bob's concern is the football schedule. He suggested they secure a definite date, time and location and bring this back to the commission. Irene also mentioned weather being a factor. The question was posed if the event would still happen even if they don't have the 915+ participants needed to break the record and Chris said yes. Bob loves the idea but agrees with Jim about waiting until 2016 which would also be an easier clean up; the field could be washed right off.
