#### Old Business:

- Music Festival total expense \$28,370.85
- Total revenue \$21,391.20
- 3450 vendors
- \$4214.20 food vendors + \$625
- \$11,227 ticket sales
- \$2500 sponsors – Snapple \$1500
- \$7237 net cost
- \$5000 actual cost for P&R to hose the festival
- 3<sup>rd</sup> stage was great
- 2<sup>nd</sup> stage went well
- Very successful overall
- Terry believes it was well run and went smooth – even vendor arrivals
- For next year we really need to stick to schedules (staff schedules)
- Minor complaint calls – mainly vendors being too close to similar vendors
- Returning vendors felt it went smoothly this year – NHS was a big help with this
- Food vendors had more space due to cancellations
- Flaming Foods will not be welcomed next year (cancellations 2 years in a row)
- Tiffany suggested carnival games for next year
- Twp doesn't have a gaming license
- Rocco said applying etc would take approximately 6 months
- Tiffany will investigate but no one present is objecting
- Rocco even said other Twp organizations can volunteer if we get the license
- Rocco will take lead and work with Tiffany on this
- Next year's date is June 6<sup>th</sup> with rain date of the 7<sup>th</sup>
- Headline band for next year needs to be determined
- This year Cheers cost \$4200, Madeline Smith \$1350
- Will need second stage also, this year RadioActive \$700, TK \$500
- Sound company was \$3000 – want to bring them back for next year
- Send band suggestions to Nikki via email by Aug 21<sup>st</sup>
- Table the beer garden for 2020 until next meeting
- Tiffany is going to check out another amusement company for some different rides
- Rocco will send Tiffany a list of amusement vendors
- Bring schedule change ideas to next meeting
- Exploring ideas for pre ticket and band sales for next year
