New Business:

- Legacy offered \$2500 for 2022 for the main stage – Donna feels we should move forward on this quote but asked Commission for thoughts – this does NOT include sound
- No one is opposed to this
- Tara also has a band who would like to be involved in any capacity
- Alan said we have time to lock in other bands and would prefer bands to come to us
- Rain date would be an issue – bands are wanting a buffer so what do we have to do
- 40 North was suggested by Rose as the second band (in between Legacy)
- Steve also has an interested band
- Alan expressed again that once the headliner is booked we have time to secure the other bands
- Donna will get a deposit sent out to Legacy
- Frank believes Spellcasters is already booked/paid rolled from 2020
- Alan suggested having a DJ on the main stage in between bands
- Donna has a call into the county to book the stage – date 6/4/22
