### New Business:

- Jodi Deery resigned 3 open spots on the Commission
- Music Festival update....
  - Vendors are starting to come back
  - o \$125 per tower (13 each) they are not being donated this year and pricing is up
  - Trying to find sponsors / donations
  - Will pre-sell wrist bands, need to determine days to sell them will need to advertise to do so – Bernie suggested 6/1 during out meeting
  - Brent spoke to the CFO and we cannot get the card readers because of the 2.6% fee
  - o Peddler's License \$250 needed
  - o Donna suggested selling the bands from the garage, not the concession stand
  - Bill suggested renting an ATM machine
  - o Evie suggested Wed/ Thurs/ Fri before the event to sell bands
  - Alan suggested Venmo or PayPal
  - Advertising must say CASH ONLY
  - Alan asked if maybe a local pizza place would sell bands for us and Steve suggested maybe to offer a sponsorship in exchange for the help
  - Donna said she is concerned about a rain date and having to refund the money if we were to do that
  - We will need to track the pre-sell of bands

- Tony said why can't we just keep sales the day of instead of having to worry about refunds
- Greg suggested selling them Wed / Thurs / Fri during the day with Township staff and then a few Parks & Recs members at night. Anne will not have the time so the Commission members will have to do it

- Too early to book the bathrooms
- OEM needs to be contacted (30 days notice)
- 9 regular vendors confirmed / 5 food vendors
- We need a flyer up ASAP for vendors
- o Food vendor fees: \$450 space / \$250 peddler (if they don't have it) / \$51 fire
- o Anne suspects food vendors are going to be an issue with these fees
- o Fire Department are exempt from Peddler fee
- o April 23<sup>rd</sup> Community Affairs craft event we can advertise there
- Tara suggested each commission member try to get 1-2 vendors
- o Brent has the banners will get them up 5-6 weeks ahead
- Waiting to hear back from 8 vendors who prepaid for 2020
- Alan is asking if the skate park can be open and if there is an attendant Brent said it will be closed
- Bernie suggested lawn signs they will be ordered ASAP
- Alan suggested mailers are a good idea but per Greg they are very expensive
