Public Portion:

- Shades of Gray (second stage band) Jim Deputy 2520 Sunset Ave
 - Disappointed from the COVID cancellation so he is excited the festival is back
 - He has pricing for a sound company if needed and connections with other bands
 - Sound \$400-500 for 4 hours – likely \$500 for both bands – will get quote
 - Also has resources for tents and stage
 - The other band will be Big City Snipers (Steve has their pricing with sound but will reprice without sound)
 - Shades of Gray uses Bob Bowling Production and would like him used if possible

- Will also get a price on the stage

New Business:

- Easter Egg Hunt 4/9 with 4/10 rain date – arrive 10am for 12 noon sharp start time
- Ladder truck confirmed
- Age groups 0-2, 3-5, 6-8, 9-12
- 4 special eggs for Visa gift cards
- 2 bunnies – Tara & Bill
- Need new decorations for the gazebo and need the tote from Duffy with other décor
- Special Needs Group – Joanna is not available to help this year and declined
- Caution tape – have it
- Snacks for “staff”
- Frank Kopa will take care of sound
- Bernie has all of the face painting supplies
- 2 carrot towers, Easter basket photo op (balloons)
- Eggs are already here
- Schools no longer send flyers
- It is advertised online and multiple other places
- Music Festival
 - Legacy and 40 North are both confirmed and POs are processed
 - Waiting on pricing for 2nd stage (Shades of Gray and Big City Snipers)
 - Alan is working on the 3rd stage
 - Spellcasters is confirmed for sound on main stage
 - Stage is ordered and confirmed
 - Vocal Velocity has been contacted
 - National Anthem still needs to be scheduled
 - Fireworks are planned for this year – they are booked
 - Parking lot vendors – Anne is waiting on approvals to post – it will be posted tomorrow
 - Food vendors \$400 mobile food unit - \$150 open air vendors – need to check ordinance because it might be \$450
 - Rides need to be ordered by April
 - Ride bands 1 for \$15, 2 for \$25, 3 for \$40 and \$10 for each additional
 - Bands will be sold at the concession stand with a rotating schedule
 - Donna said the fire department offered to lend their credit card reader
 - Would need Township iPad to run it
 - An account would need to be set up but it would eliminate cash
 - But will there be a percentage taken out?
 - Evie doesn't think there would be if it goes direct to an account for non-profit
 - Bands themselves need to be ordered
 - What about pre-purchase of bands? Set up a day at the Pfeiffer
 - Port-o-pots are getting ordered
 - Touch base with OEM
 - Generators
 - Walkie talkies, cones, guiders
 - Need map (blueprint)

- Budget is not yet done
- Donna wants to know how we go about asking for more money in the budget
- Brent will need to make the request
- Beer Garden – Donna believes the vote last month wasn't necessary because we already had agreed to get rid of it
- Donna is against the way it was done because we didn't make any money off it
- Donna asked if breweries and wineries can come in as vendors instead of beer gardens
- Greg needs to check into the legality of it
- It would have to go through an ordinance for the fee schedule
- Tony said he believes a liquor license would be needed
- Bernie suggested putting good and wine on the inner perimeter – more mixing so vendors get more traffic
- Is \$400 a fair price for wine / beer vendor – let's check the legality first

Director's Report:

- Everything is going great – we are at the mercy of the weather
- Donna mentions we need the banners

Council Report – nothing at this time other than good job
