- Commission agreed on booking 40 North for 2023 Music Festival – they have been contacted and awaiting reply
- A slide will be added to replace the bull next year at the festival
- Registration date for all vendors for the festival will be strictly enforced

New Business:

- 3 wagons ready for pick up 10/17
- Popcorn & cracker jacks are ordered \$247.46
- Candy bags and candy are ordered \$113.93 and \$1867.86
- ROTC has been contacted
- Prize costs \$97.90

- St Mary’s for the walkers – Patty and Sue
- Need walkie talkies
- Games are ready for the festival
- Scrap the idea of giving out the candy bags at the festival
- Go back to giving out candy bags at the parade
- Matt suggested giving the bags out in 2 places at the parade
- Need lights and heater for St Mary’s

- Donna wants to stick with 1 area for the candy hand outs – it should be right after the judges stand
- Next year possibly introduce a pet costume contest
- Donna will send out the parade line up
- October meeting meet at 6pm to fill candy bags but meeting starts at 7pm
- Need string for the bags
- Meet at 7am for the Fall Festival
- Meet at 4pm for the parade
- We need to decide if we want to keep the tree lighting as the reverse parade or go back to the old way
- Donna already reached out for the sleigh
- Need the snow maker again
- Need a new Santa
- Commission wants to stay with the parade format
- Tara suggested handing out flyers for the Christmas event at the parade
- Businesses need to be contacted for Christmas
