Background Checks:

Organizations are responsible for sending their coaches lists to Tiffany prior to the season beginning and then updating her through out the season with any changes or additions. Tiffany will send out a master list to all organizations to cross reference their coaches to see if they are approved.

Badge clearance takes appx 5 weeks from the start of the application process to final approval. In some cases this could be over half the season. Tiffany is looking into solution to speed up the process.

Permits:

Parks:

Discussion of bathrooms at the parks. Little league is having issues with bathrooms and plumbing in the bathrooms attached to the clubhouse. Unclear who's responsibility the upkeep and maintenance falls to. Basketball had issues this summer with no bathrooms being available for the summer league. Tiffany stated moving forward there will be port a potties. Little league also stated they will try to help with having bathrooms available.

Many organizations asked if park attendants could be more helpful in maintaining and supervising the bathrooms. Tiffany and Joe are attempting to change the responsibilities of the park attendants. Some presidents asked for more police presence at the parks, maybe even having some type of law enforcement official on hand.

Owen's will be receiving new updated cameras.

Stintson hockey rink is slowly being taken down. Hockey asked if the new rink will be decked, Tiffany stated they are unsure due to needing an area for kids to skate with the skate park being closed permanently. Joe stated they are looking into the cost of moving the light poles to increase the size of the hockey rink. Tiffany asked hockey what size rink would be optimal for their use (games, tournaments) and hockey stated the same size the Stintson rink is at currently would be fine. They could break down age groups. Hockey said they would look into raising the funds to get the rink decked.

Lacrosse asked to use the football game field on Friday nights in the spring for their girls league. Football stated that would not be an issue.
